Stoneware with greenish-gray (celadon) glaze and white clay inlaid (sanggam) decoration

## **Description**

Small dish of gray stoneware has sloping sides and slightly everted rim. Thick glaze is warm greenish-gray and finely crackled. An accidentally unglazed patch on the outside has fired orange. Grit adheres to the partly unglazed foot-ring and glazed base. Inlaid decoration of off-white slip consists of chrysanthemum-like flowers inside two concentric rings. On the exterior are three small flowers.
