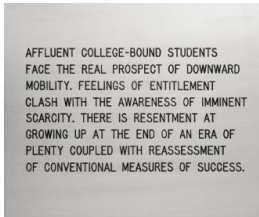

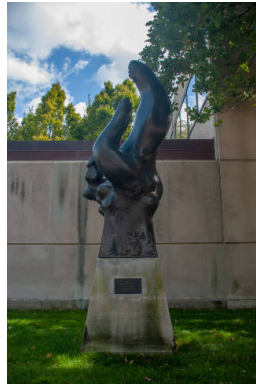

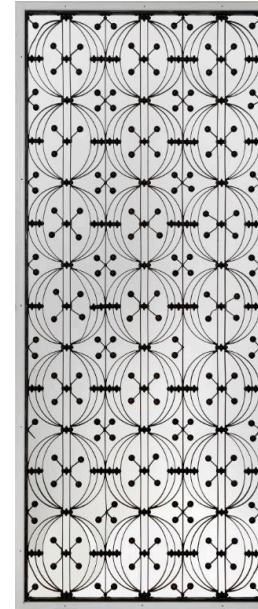

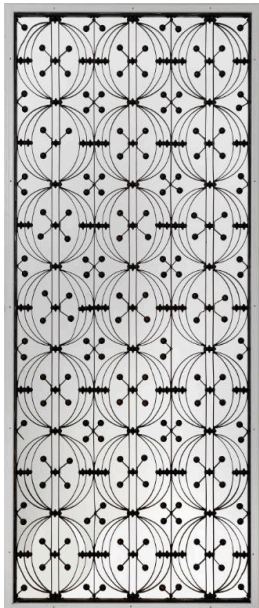


**Title:** Elevator Enclosure Screen
